


THE "AURORA" INUKSHUK

Using the Belvedere Wall Stone, you can create a beautiful and truly Canadian accent to add to your landscape. It has the look of natural stone, will take less than 10 minutes to assemble, allowing you more time to relax and enjoy life.



Assembly and Materials List

1 small tube adhesive (wear gloves), 1 pc. "A", 1 pc "B", 2 pc "C", 2 pc "D", 2 pc "E", 2 pc "F"

Before you begin assembly, find a location to suit your Inukshuk, make sure you have an area that is approx. 24" x 10". Dig a hole to the above dimensions and approx 3-4" deep.

Fill the hole with gravel (ask your local supplier for "Granular A") and compact it so when you walk on it, you do not sink in.

or

If you want to place the Inukshuk on a hard surface, that is also acceptable, (use adhesive)

You can now begin assembly as per the drawing, with some adhesive between each layer of stone.

The adhesive will help keep the Inukshuk in place as well as prevent injury due to falling stone.

Note: This statue can be placed anywhere you like, but a flat solid surface is ideal - either a prepared surface in a garden or on a deck or patio.

Alternative base. Use 2-12"x12" patio stones -place one under each leg with adhesive.

Once cured, you can place topsoil or mulch over the patio stones for a more natural appearance.
